These Student Terms and Conditions ("Student Terms") govern the access to and use of the 4sch school management system (the "Service") by students. The Service is operated by **4sch Software as a Service Venture** ("4sch", "we", "us", or "our").

These Student Terms apply to all students who access or use the Service through a subscribing school. Where a student is under the age of 18 or otherwise considered a minor under applicable law, these Student Terms are accepted on the student's behalf by a parent, legal guardian, or the subscribing school acting in loco parentis.

By accessing or using the Service, you agree to comply with these Student Terms.

1. Purpose of the Service

The Service is provided to support educational activities, including academic management, communication, learning administration, and school-related record keeping.

Students may only use the Service for lawful, educational, and school-authorized purposes.

2. Eligibility and Access

2.1 Access to the Service is granted solely through a School that has an active subscription with 4sch.

2.2 Student accounts are created and managed by the School. Students may not create independent accounts without School authorization.

2.3 Access rights, features, and permissions are determined by the School and may vary by role, class, or level.

3. Student Responsibilities

Students agree to:

- Use the Service respectfully, responsibly, and in accordance with school rules;
- Provide accurate information where required;

- Keep login credentials confidential;
- Respect the privacy and rights of other users;
- Report any misuse, security issues, or unauthorized access to the School.

Students must not share login details or allow others to access their accounts.

4. Acceptable Use and Conduct

Students must not:

- Use the Service for bullying, harassment, hate speech, or abusive behavior;
- Upload or share inappropriate, offensive, or unlawful content;
- Attempt to bypass security controls or gain unauthorized access;
- Impersonate other users or falsify records;
- Use the Service for commercial or non-educational purposes.

Violations may result in disciplinary action by the School, suspension of access, or account termination.

5. Academic Records and Content

5.1 Academic records, submissions, grades, attendance data, and related materials are managed by the School.

5.2 Students do not own academic records stored in the Service but may have rights of access as determined by School policies and applicable law.

5.3 Students retain ownership of original content they submit, subject to the School's academic policies.

6. Privacy and Data Protection

6.1 Student Personal Data is processed in accordance with the 4sch Privacy Policy and applicable data protection laws, including the Nigeria Data Protection Act, 2023.

6.2 4sch processes student data under the authority of the School and, where applicable, the student's parent or guardian.

6.3 Students should direct privacy-related requests to their School, unless otherwise instructed.

7. Parental and Guardian Rights

7.1 Parents and legal guardians may be granted access to student information as determined by the School.

7.2 Parents and guardians may exercise data protection rights on behalf of students, subject to applicable law and School policies.

8. Intellectual Property

All software, system content, and platform materials remain the intellectual property of 4sch.

Students are granted a limited, non-transferable, revocable right to use the Service for educational purposes only.

9. Suspension and Termination

9.1 A School may suspend or terminate a student's access at any time in accordance with its internal policies.

9.2 4sch may restrict access where required to protect system integrity, security, or legal compliance.

10. Disclaimers

The Service is provided on an "as is" and "as available" basis.

4sch does not guarantee uninterrupted access or error-free operation and is not responsible for academic outcomes.

11. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by law, 4sch shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, or consequential damages arising from student use of the Service.

12. Governing Law

These Student Terms shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.
